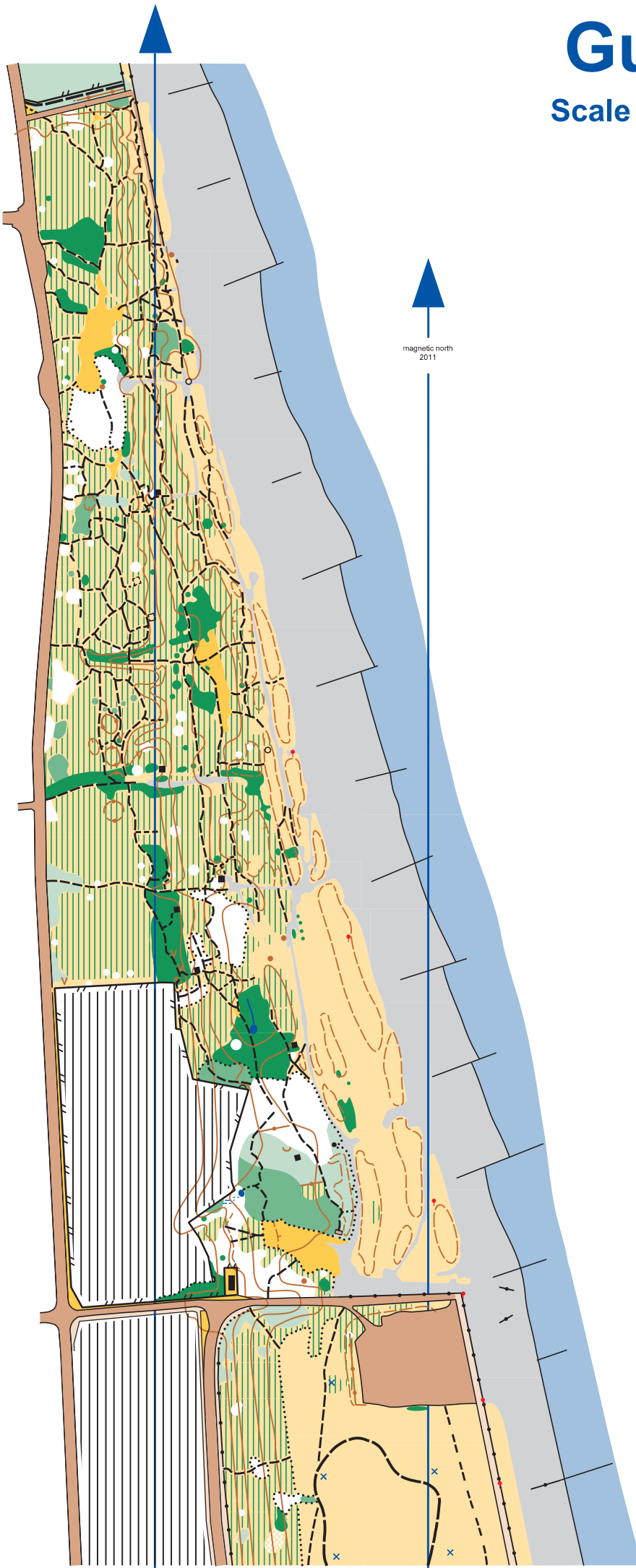


Gunton Denes
